Peace Poster Contest Instructions

Educators: We invite all educators to use this contest as an opportunity for student dialog and reflection on the role youth play in creating a peaceful future. Our hope is that all of your students will create a poster, however, please submit a maximum of five posters from each class (period) that best convey this year's theme. Theme: "YOUth: Creating a Peaceful Future."

Format: Poster board, 22 X 28 inches, two-dimensional media only, weather-resistant (recommended for purposes of our display).

"Student Entry Form" must be on back of poster: Completed by student and parent and securely attached to the back of the poster. Posters submitted without completed Student Entry Forms will NOT be eligible to win. (As a back up in the event of detachment, write name of student, school and grade level, teacher's name and contact information (phone number and/or e-mail address) on back of poster.

Deadline for submission: 6 pm Friday, September 10, 2010. Mail posters and supporting information to Honoka'a Hongwanji Buddhist Temple P.O. Box 1667, Honoka'a, HI 96727. Call 808 775-7232 to make arrangements to drop off the posters. Posters submitted will be considered a donation to the Peace Committee and will not be returned.

Prizes: First, Second, Third prizes (\$50, \$35 and \$25) for each grade category, K-3, 4-6, 7-9, 10-12. Grand Prize for "Best in Show" – \$100 and one night stay for winner and parents at Waianuhea Bed & Breakfast, Ahualoa, Big Island (minimum value \$200).
