## General Instructions

Students and parents must complete the Student Entry Form, including poster description and parental permission signature.

Securely attach the completed form to the back of the poster. In event the Entry Form is separated, also write the student’s name, school, grade, teacher name and contact information (email or phone contact) directly on the back of the poster. Posters without parental permission are not eligible to win the prizes.

The deadline for submission is October 21, 2022 to the Honokaa Heritage Center, 45-3490 Mamane Street, Suite C, Honokaa HI 96727.

To be eligible to win any prize, **the poster must be 22 inches by 18 inches**, using any choice of media. (Weather proofing is recommended.) A limited supply of poster boards will be available at the Honokaa Heritage Center (808 437-1947)
